



Ear PIERCING

SAINT ALPHONSUS MEDICAL GROUP

offers ear piercing performed by a trained healthcare professional under the supervision of a licensed provider.

We use the Blomdahl® Medical Ear Piercing System which minimizes the chance of infection and eliminates the risk of nickel allergy and patient-to-patient cross-contamination.

Pricing:

One ear: \$45

Both ears: \$60

Includes ear piercing, earrings, numbing cream, and aftercare education.

- For ages 3 months and older
- Providing piercing for the lower ear lobe only
- Up to two piercings in each ear, each set of piercings must be scheduled at different visits
- Not performed during well or sick visits

PROCEDURE:

1. A parent or legal guardian must be present.
2. Arrive 30 minutes early to allow for the application of the numbing cream.
3. Cooperation during the piercing is required. If it is deemed unsafe, the appointment will be canceled or rescheduled. Refunds are available for canceled appointments.
4. A Surgical/Procedural Informed Consent form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
5. Appropriate infection prevention procedures, including hand hygiene, cleansing of the front and back of the ear lobe, and disposal of waste after the procedure, will be followed.

AFTER CARE:

Piercings heal in the first 6 weeks, but can take up to 6 months to completely heal.

1. Wash hands with soap prior to touching pierced ears.
2. Clean piercing thoroughly twice a day, using liquid soap and clean running water at least once a day (preferably after showering or washing the hair).
3. Unlike conventional ear piercings, there is no need to rotate the Blomdahl® studs to prevent them from adhering to the skin.
4. Keep the pierced area clean and dry.
5. Cover earrings with band aids during sports to prevent them from being pulled off the ear.
6. Do not remove earrings for first 6 weeks.
7. After removing earrings, do not go longer than 24 hours without earrings for first 6 months.

If pain, redness, swelling, or pus drainage from the piercing occurs within the first week, this can be a sign of infection. Please contact our office for a follow-up appointment.
